JOURNAL ENTRY

Keeping a diary of your tremor symptoms can help determine impact on your daily life and assist a doctor in making an accurate diagnosis.

This symptom diary is intended to provide a record of your experience over a period of days or weeks. A written record will help highlight patterns of symptoms you experience and help you communicate your experience with your doctor more effectively.

The types of information you ma	ıy
want to record can include:	

- When tremors occur (at rest or during movement)
- What areas of your body are affected and duration
- Types of activities that are impacted (walking, writing, eating, dressing, etc.)
- Other daily circumstances that may have an impact on your symptoms (stress, fatigue, alcohol, caffeine, etc.)
- How your symptoms impact your personal and/or professional life (work, social activities, recreation activities, mental or emotional health)
- Any family history of ET or other neurological conditions
- Any additional information that may be helpful for your doctor
